Standards Based Grading adopted to Mathematics Courses

Abstract:

Standards based grading is an innovative grading scheme which is based on a student's mastery of course learning outcomes or standards. Final grades are determined by the instructor's choice of specifications for each letter grade. One key feature is that students can initiate re-assessment opportunities which can replace earlier scores.

In this talk, we will describe the standards based grading scheme and how it was adopted to some mathematics courses. We will also describe the benefits observed, and efficient ways to implement the scheme including keeping a grade book and how to set up office hour re-assessments. :
