Hello Anthony,

I have brought this up to the Math Club Executive Board and since there are at least two other conferences that students are looking to attend, each student can only receive \$100 per conference. That is, we can only grant you \$300 as of right now. However, if we have any money left over in the budget at the end of the year, we would be happy to reimburse you.

Please consider the \$300 a reimbursement for registration fees and any travel costs. This means that you can only receive the money after the conference is over with receipts to account for the \$300. Please note that this money cannot be used to cover the cost of food or drink, as per SGA guidelines.

I also wanted to let you know that for JMM there is a significant cost reduction for the registration if you are a member of MAA or KME!
